Since 2011 Eastern Mediterranean University has been the official Cyprus centre for WMG, University of Warwick MSc programmes in Engineering Business Management and Supply Chain and Logistics Management.

These highly prestigious MSc degrees can be completed in just one full year of academic study on the EMU campus, and include an option for taking two modules in the UK and other overseas centres.

All Eastern Mediterranean University students receive an automatic 20% scholarship with up to 40% offered according to academic performance at undergraduate level.

Previous students on the program have come from a wide-range of backgrounds, including engineering, business, tourism, architecture and information technology. In all cases the students have been motivated by the desire to gain not only a top class world-renowned degree but the practical knowledge and skills required of top managers in both the world of industry and the service sector.

The University of Warwick is currently ranked number 9 in the UK according to the Guardian 2017 ranking of universities, and number 51 in the world (QS System). Hence, these programs offer the chance to get a full postgraduate degree from one of the world's top Universities.

Entry Qualifications

Students joining the WMG MSc programme for Engineering Business Management will normally have completed an undergraduate degree in engineering, economics, or other related field.

For Supply Chain and Logistics Management, all related fields may be considered. Previous students have been graduates from a number of different fields, including Business, Banking, Architecture and Tourism.

You should normally have a minimum CGPA of 2.7 or second class honours degree, and an English proficiency level of minimum IELTS 6.5.

Entry Options and Pathways

You are academically qualified but your English level is not yet at IELTS 6.5	You could consider registering at EMU and taking postgraduate English courses and some departmental courses in EMU until you have successfully gained IELTS 6.5. Consult our office for further advice.		
You are fully qualified and will be a full-time student	Apply for the full time MSc		
You are slightly below the required entry qualifications	Consult our office. You may still be offered a conditional entry to the programme.		
You would like a qualification in the field but have limited time available.	 Successfully passing three modules of the WMG MSc programme will entitle you to the WMG Postgraduate Award. Successfully passing six modules of the WMG MSc programme will entitle you to the WMG Postgraduate Certificate. Furthermore once you have successfully completed a sub-award, you will be able to reapply at a later date to complete the next part of the programme. 		
You are in employment	You can apply as a part-time student. You would then have three years to complete the full MSc programme.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long does the WMG MSc Programme take to complete?

The full MSc programme comprises nine modules and a project, and full-time students are expected to complete all programme requirements in one calendar year. Students registering part-time on the programme have a maximum of three years to complete programme requirements.

Is this a 'joint programme'?

No, the programme is delivered entirely by WMG, University of Warwick. Eastern Mediterranean University does however offer exemptions on its own programmes for students who have successfully completed WMG modules; some students take advantage of this to complete two Master's degrees within a 24-30 month period.

How is the course delivered?

Each module comprises one week of intensive full-day instruction, followed by a 4000-5000 word assignment to be completed within 6 weeks of the end of the module. The nine assignments count for 50% of the overall course grade. The project, which you will start working on from the beginning of the course, is approximately 15,000-20,000 words. The project counts for 50% of the final grade for the MSc.The modules are delivered by WMG staff who come to EMU for the intensive week along with specialists at EMU. You will also have a project and course supervisor at EMU.

Can we take modules at other WMG Centres?

Acceptance on courses at other centres is at the discretion of each centre. As part of your course fee you may apply to attend two modules in another WMG Centre, including the University of Warwick in the UK. Local centres are allowed to charge an additional cost for any hospitality; you would of course be responsible for any extra expenses occurred (e.g. transportation, visas, accommodation etc.). Other options include spending time at one of WMG's centres in the far east, e.g. Hong Kong, China, India, Singapore, Thailand and Malaysia.

When can we enrol?

The programme normally begins in September, but it is possible to enrol at other times of the year.
